FLAGSHIP PROGRAM

Our flagship program is our **learning** garden program, which began in 2015 and offers from \$500 to \$3,000 grants to 40-50 schools across the country each year.

We offer in school, in class and teacher training to schools. We have provided learning garden grants to 234 schools over the last six years.
